Situation

Located just a short walk from Rickmansworth and opposite the prestigious Royal Masonic School. The Metropolitan and Main Line railway services to Baker Street and Marylebone are available from Rickmansworth Station. The Aquadrome in Rickmansworth offers two boating lakes and a network of paths around the park, Grand Union Canal and wildlife sanctuary.
